



Alternatives Unlimited Online Tutoring

Online Tutoring Setup and Format

Survey to determine online needs: After enrollment, Alternatives Unlimited will contact parent/guardian to determine online needs. AU will deliver computer and all necessary materials needed for the SES tutoring program. **@ NO CHARGE**

Computer Delivery and Set up: Computer will be delivered to the home in a lock down mode. Student will receive a detailed set of directions for setting up online program. Tech support will be provided to assist with the set up process and downloading the software for the online tutoring program. **@ NO CHARGE**

Pre-Test and Learning Plan: Student will take the online Pre-test before beginning the SES online tutoring program.

Learning Plan Created: An individual learning plan is developed based on students' needs in combination with district requirements and state standards.

Tutoring Begins: Lessons will be created and released based on the individual learning plan.

Delivery format:

- 1. Required Online “Live” SES Tutoring Session:** Students will sign in and participate in the required minimum number of online SES tutoring hours during a weekly window of time. Students may not exceed the maximum number of tutoring hours as required by each district.
- 2. Activities and Skill Practice:** Students have unlimited access to logon to the AU website to practice and master skills through a variety of interactive activities. These practice activities are above and beyond the required SES tutoring program and are not counted towards the SES program tutoring hours.

Typical One-hour Online Session Includes

Sign On: Student logon for attendance.

Review and Warm-up Activity: Students can see notes from the tutor based on the last tutoring session and activities. Student will work on a new activity which reinforces prior knowledge.

Video Lesson of Target Concept: Student will view a video lesson that teaches a new targeted skill based grade and skill level of the student. The student will interact with the video lesson via questions posed with fill in the blank or multiple choice answers.

Activities, Assignments, Educational Games: Using an interactive platform, the student will engage in activities and assignments that correspond with the video lesson. The tutor has the ability to observe and “peek in” on the student and provide additional support as needed. In addition, the student will be able to “raise their hand” to ask a question/help. Note: Students do not have the capability to interact with other students. They can only work with the tutor.

Individual/Guided Practice: Tutors may revisit any skills not mastered during the initial lesson and provide further activities to assist with mastering the objective.

Wrap-up: Tutor will upload the appropriate **PAL packet activities (Parent Assisted Learning for Grades K - 6)** for the student and parent to work on outside of the tutoring session to create the school to home connection and further mastery of the skill

Activities and Skill Practice: The student will have access to complete activities above and beyond the required tutoring sessions through the online platform.

Progress Reporting: Parents will be able to access student progress online. Parents may also communicate with tutors and District Coordinators as needed.
