#### SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

#### Back to School 2021/22 Learning Plans

Dr. Sefcik reported that on July 9, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Illinois Department of Public Health, and the Illinois State Board of Education issued updated public health guidance for COVID-10 prevention in schools. With this new information the District is finalizing our Back to School Learning Plan. She presented the Back to School Learning Plan that included an overview of key takeaways regarding: vaccinations, mitigations, screening testing, prevention strategies, Schoology use, academic resources, SEL support, attendance and re-engagement efforts, grading/exams, food service, and transportation. The District will follow the recommended guidance with masking optional for those that are fully vaccinated; and individuals not fully unvaccinated should continue to mask. Mask wearing will be on the honor system, and the focus will be on teaching and learning rather than mask enforcement.

#### **Deep Equity Partnership**

Dr. Sefcik informed the Board that the District is planning to partner with Fox Lake Grade School District 114 and Grayslake Community High School District 127 for Corwin's Deep Equity School Leadership Team. This is a multi-year process. The leadership training, taking place in year one, will include all three districts. Year two, which will include the student component, will include Grant and Grayslake only. Deep Equity training is an evidence-based process that has been shown to have a measurable, positive impact on student outcomes.

#### Bilingual Liaison Partnership

Dr. Sefcik recommended approval of a shared Bilingual Parent Liaison, partnering with Gavin School District 37 and Fox Lake Grade School District 114. She provided a draft of the job description for the position that will be finalized soon. With a growing population of English Learners in our districts and additional statutory requirements with this program, we seek to jointly employ a shared bilingual parent liaison to supplement current administrative efforts. Gavin and Fox Lake would each receive 2 days per week and contribute 40% of the position costs each and Grant would be allocated 1 day per week for 20% of the position costs.

#### **BUSINESS AFFAIRS**

#### Unaudited Summary of Year End 2020/21

Mrs. Reich provided an unaudited summary of fiscal year end 2020/21. She noted that the year ended in a better position than expected due to an additional property tax payment that came through on June 30<sup>th</sup>.

#### Final 2021/22 Budget

Mrs. Reich presented the final 2021/22 budget. She updated the tentative budget with all new hires, adjusted the federal ESSER grant funds, and trimmed expenses extensively. The budget has been on public display for the required 30 days.

#### Fees

Mrs. Reich informed the Board that each year school fees are reviewed. These fees charged to families offset the cost of items supplied by the District for all students. Examples of items included in these fees are textbooks, workbooks, consumables, supplies, library resources, copying costs, etc. She supplied the Board with a listing of fees from comparable districts. She does not recommend increasing fees at this time.

#### National School Lunch Program

Mrs. Reich stated the District typically participates in the National School Lunch Program which allows families who qualify to receive either reduced pricing or completely free lunches. This past year, however, we qualified for a special waiver from the United States Department of Agriculture which allowed us to provide free meals to all students. We qualify again this year for that waiver under a program called Seamless Summer Option, and will again serve lunches to all students at no cost. Each meal served is claimed and the federal government reimburses the district \$4.3175 per meal. This will be the final year we will qualify with the USDA and plan to go back to the National School Lunch Program in the 2022/23 school year.

#### OTHER BUSINESS

Dr. Sefcik said the District received and fulfilled a Freedom of Information Act request.

Dr. Sefcik clarified that the Booster Club members are an extension of our staff, so will be under the same mitigation requirements. However, they may open fully for the 21/22 school year with mitigations in place.

### Resolution - School Operations During COVID-19 Pandemic

WHEREAS, due to the ongoing pandemic, all areas of the State of Illinois continue to be declared a disaster area; and

WHEREAS, public health guidelines remain subject to ongoing clarification and modification as necessary to prevent or slow the spread of COVID-19 and protect public health during the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE), which has authority to administer attendance and school calendar requirements, to interpret graduation requirements, and to oversee the allocation of resources for nutrition, transportation, and other crucial aspects of public education has provided written guidance, subject to ongoing clarification and modification, to Illinois school boards and their districts on issues related to COVID-19, including but not limited to student attendance, e-learning, meal distribution, transportation, special education, and other issues; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board recognizes the need for ongoing flexibility in addressing instructional, operational, and staffing considerations in response to emerging and changing guidance and requirements from the State of Illinois, Illinois State Board of Education, Illinois Department of Public Health, Centers for Disease Control, Lake County Public Health Department, and other entities.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education recognizes that complying with applicable public health requirements and guidelines will require that the District modify its standard operations for an undetermined period during the 2021-22 school year;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Education of Grant Community High School District 124, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: The Board grants the Superintendent and the Superintendent's designees the flexibility to modify and implement the instructional and other educational programs and the operations of the District for and during the 2021-22 school year as necessary to adapt to changing guidelines and public health requirements. This authority includes the exercise of discretion in determining the appropriate COVID-19 prevention, mitigation, and response strategies to be implemented in the District, and the authority to implement any rules necessary to implement such strategies. The Superintendent will consult with the Board President over any substantive changes to instructional and other educational programs or the operations of the District and will report regularly to the Board regarding modifications and ongoing efforts to implement current guidance and requirements.

<u>Section 2:</u> The Superintendent is authorized, after consultation with the Board President and notification to the Board, to close any school building or District facility without further action by the Board during any period of modified operations, including until such time as the Superintendent, in consultation with appropriate local, State, and federal health and government authorities, deems it in the best interests of the District and its students to open schools.

<u>Section 3:</u> The Superintendent is authorized, based upon the needs of the District and the guidance from local, State, and federal health and government agencies, to direct staff assignments and working conditions during any period of modified operations, provided that the Board approve any needed modifications to applicable bargaining agreements or Board policies.

<u>Section 4:</u> Access to the District's school grounds and school buildings or facilities may be limited as directed by the Superintendent during any period of modified operations and to prevent or slow the spread of COVID-19 and protect public health during the COVID-19 pandemic.

<u>Section 5:</u> The Board authorizes the Superintendent to suspend any portions of its policies or any policies in their entirety during any period of modified operations, if the suspension is necessary to implement current public health guidance and requirements for the 2021-22 school year. In such case, the Superintendent will notify the Board of the policy suspension; and, the Board may override the Superintendent's policy suspension by passage of a proper motion or resolution.

<u>Section 7:</u> This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.

### EXTRACURRICULAR AND CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

An extracurricular activity is defined as any activity associated with athletics and falls under the direct supervision and management of the athletic director. A co-curricular activity is any non-extracurricular activity that has a sponsor or director who supervises and manages students within that area of interest.

The Superintendent must approve an activity in order to be considered a Districtsponsored extracurricular or co-curricular activity, using the following criteria:

- 1. The activity will contribute to the leadership abilities, social well-being, self-realization, good citizenship or general growth of student-participants.
- 2. Fees assessed students are reasonable and do not exceed the actual cost of operation.
- 3. The District has sufficient financial resources for the activity.
- 4. The interest of the student body is considered.
- 5. The activity will be supervised by a school-approved coach or sponsor.

### Academic Criteria for Participation

The selection of members or participants is at the discretion of the teachers, sponsors or coaches, provided that the selection criteria conform to the District's policies. In order to be eligible to participate in any school-sponsored extracurricular or co-curricular activity, a student must comply with the guidelines established by the IHSA of passing five (5) full-time courses or 25 hours per week and have successfully passed five (5) full-time courses the previous semester. Any student-participant failing to meet these academic criteria shall not be able to participate in the activity until the specified academic criteria are met.

Principal's Report to the Board of Education Jeremy Schmidt, Principal August 2021

### **Summer School**

As the School Board is well aware, this past summer we ran the most robust summer school program in memory. With the changes made due to pandemic circumstances, there were opportunities for enrichment, in person credit recovery, remote credit recovery, summer academy, and extended school year. The entire program ultimately consisted of 98 incoming freshmen, 208 tenth through twelfth graders earning enrichment credits, 243 tenth through twelfth graders recovering credits, and 14 students participating in Extended School Year and English Language programming. The free, district-offered transportation proved valuable for many students, as 132 took advantage of the opportunity. To facilitate the program, 32 teachers were recruited to staff the multitude of course offerings.

### **New Teacher Orientation**

This year's New Teacher Orientation was successfully run over two and a half days from August 4 - August 6. After last year's modified program due to COVID, this year, we were able to return to a more traditional program. Administrators, Peer Mentors, and Instructional Coaches all contributed to the robust program. The goal of the orientation is to instill core instructional values in our new staff beginning with their first day as Bulldogs. The program generally consists of three parts: operational basics, instructional strategies, and mentor work. The program provides new teachers all the tools they will need to be effective from day one in the classroom as well as providing an opportunity to introduce new certified staff to the climate and culture of Grant.

### **Back-to-School Professional Development**

Returning from the turbulence of the past year and a half, this year's August 9th and 10th Back-to-School Institute days professional development was focused on developing our staff's social and emotional competency. Dr. Doug Bolton was the keynote speaker on the afternoon of August 9, speaking to every certified and non-certified staff member in the Fieldhouse about building resilience. Mandatory, building-wide training for certified staff was hosted by the deans, student services, the PBIS team, and administrators including *Being a Bulldog* preparations and safety planning. Additionally, a variety of self-selected instructional and technology training on Schoology, GoGuardian, NEAT bars, and Skyward were hosted by Instructional Coaches. Moreover, PLTs and departmental-level meetings were held to focus expectations and prepare instructional plans.

Additionally, professional development opportunities continued throughout the week. On teachers' free periods during *Being a Bulldog* days, Instructional Coaches were able to meet one-on-one with teachers providing individualized instructional support.

### **New Student Enrollment**

As a public school, new student enrollment is ongoing, or rolling, throughout the course of the entire calendar year. The most difficult enrollments to manage operationally are those that come just before the start of the school year. Year-to-year, the late enrollment trends vary widely, but this year has been particularly challenging. From June 24 through August 12, 68 new students have enrolled, met with counselors, and have schedules. Another 17 new students have enrolled and have counselor appointments and are awaiting schedules. Another 21 new students have submitted enrollment packets, had their residency verified, and need to schedule counselor appointments. With these numbers, there will be over 100 new student enrollments in the weeks leading up to school, and this represents the most significant number of late enrollments in many, many years.

### Being a Bulldog

At the time of this report, the alternative *Being a Bulldog* start to the year is underway. The reorientation days have not yet concluded, but so far, the alternative schedules have been achieving their goals: to re-generate culture around what it means to *Be a Bulldog* through programming to re-establish connectivity to the school community while creating a low-stress transition back onto campus.

The final schedule for each day incorporated time in TEAM rooms, a kick-off assembly, an abbreviated full day's schedule with icebreakers linked to Portrait of a Bulldog competencies, reorientation meetings with RED Teams, and an Activity Fair.




# Background

- These funds are to help safely reopen and sustain the safe operation of schools, as well as address the impact of the coronavirus pandemic on the nation's students.
- The \$1.5 million in allocated funds may be used for expenses from March 13, 2020 through September 30,2023.
- Not less than twenty percent (20%) of the ARP ESSER allocation is to be used to address learning loss through the implementation of evidence-based interventions and ensure that those interventions respond to students' social, emotional, and academic needs.
- Each grant recipient is to seek public comment on its plan for the safe return to in-person instruction, and subsequently post its plan on its website.





- Grant CHSD #124 will fully return to school with in-person instruction for the 2021-22 school year.
- Additional staffing, materials, and SEL supports will be provided for students.

District 124 is planning to return to full capacity, in-person learning for the 2021-22 school year. We will remain responsive to regulatory guidance, local health metrics and will inform families if changes are needed to our learning plans.

The District will begin the 2021-22 school year with restrictions still in place as per updated guidance from Centers for Disease Control and Prevention *Guidance for COVID-19 Prevention in K-12 Schools*, subsequently adopted by the Illinois Department of Public Health and Illinois State Board of Education. Additionally, the Learning Plan has been amended to comply with the masking mandate announced by Governor Pritzker on August 4, 2021.

### Instructional Plan: Full capacity, in-person learning

- All students shall be physically present in the school building.\*
- Physical distancing of 3' in instructional areas and cafeterias will be observed, to the greatest extent possible.
- Masks shall be required for all teachers, staff, students, and visitors in school and when on school buses, regardless of vaccination status.
- Screening testing, enhanced ventilation, handwashing and respiratory etiquette, staying home when sick and getting tested, contact tracing in combination with quarantine and isolation, and cleaning and disinfection strategies will be in effect.

\*It should be noted that the District has received direction from the Illinois State Board of Education that all students shall be present in-person for the 2021-22 school year. However, students with significant medical conditions that place them at increased risk of illness due to COVID-19 or students that are unwilling or unable to comply with increased mitigation measures may apply for a fully remote learning option with Edgenuity and/or Illinois Virtual High School. This election will be for the duration of the first semester. Students electing this option may return to in-person learning for the Spring of 2022. Additional details on remote learning may be found <a href="here">here</a>. Families who wish to apply for fully remote learning must complete a <a href="#Fall 2021">Fall 2021</a> PM.

The District has developed multiple instructional plans for potential implementation should an alternate form of learning be required locally or by the State. Those alternate plans will be shared, if it becomes necessary.

### **Layered Mitigation Strategies**

The following layered mitigation strategies will be in effect at all times when on campus:

### **Contact Tracing in Combination with Isolation and Quarantine:**

- The District Contact Tracing Team will identify close contacts and positive cases and take appropriate isolation and quarantine measures, in partnership with the local health department.
- The District shall report positive cases to the local health department, as required.
- Fully vaccinated individuals in close contact with someone who has COVID-19 but do NOT have COVID-19 symptoms do not need to quarantine, but screening is recommended 3-5 days after potential exposure.

### **Face Coverings:**

- Masks shall be required for all teachers, staff, students, and visitors in school and when on school buses, regardless of vaccination status.
- In general, masks do not need to be worn outdoors.
- Per IDPH and IHSA guidance, different rules may apply for masking during athletics beyond the school day. A masking change related to athletics was announced by IHSA on 8/4/21 requiring "masks to be worn for all indoor IHSA athletic events regardless of an individual's vaccination status. This mask directive for indoor athletic events applies to student-athletes, coaches, officials, game personnel, and fans." August 4 IDPH and IHSA Update.
- Masks should meet one of the following criteria:
  - CDC mask recommendations
  - ASTM International Standard Specification for Barrier Face Coverings
  - NIOSH Workplace Performance and Workplace Performance Plus masks
- Students should come to school with their own mask every day, but we will have a limited supply of disposable face coverings in the event that an individual does not have one for use.

### Hand Hygiene:

• Students and staff must practice good hand hygiene, including washing hands frequently for 20 seconds or using hand sanitizer when washing is not available. There will be hand sanitizer stationed around the building for staff and student use. Students should also carry a personal supply of hand sanitizer to ensure constant access.

#### **Health Checks and Illness:**

Health checks are no longer required.

- Persons should not report to school if they have any currently known <u>symptoms of</u>
   <u>COVID-19</u>, they are positive for COVID-19, or if unvaccinated and have been in close contact with someone that tested positive for COVID-19.
- Any individual presenting with COVID-19 symptoms will be moved to a quarantine area
  and assessed by the school nurse or qualified professional, including the administration of
  a SHIELD PCR test, if consent is provided. If necessary, a parent or guardian may be
  requested to immediately pick up a student.
- Students or staff members who test positive will not be allowed to return to school until CDC/IDPH/LCHD standards for recovery have been met.
- Whenever possible, the school will notify families if a student was potentially exposed to COVID-19 in the school setting.
- Parents/staff are required to notify the school district if students/staff have been exposed to COVID-19.
- PCR and antigen testing will be available as an additional mitigation measure for symptomatic and asymptomatic individuals.

### **Physical Distancing:**

• Physical distancing of 3' in instructional areas and cafeterias will be observed, to the greatest extent possible.

### **Sanitation:**

- Schools will be cleaned and sanitized every day, including regular use of electrostatic sprayers in learning spaces.
- Classrooms will have ample disinfectant for use throughout the day. Desks and other frequently touched classroom equipment may be wiped between classes.
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the building for staff and student use.

### **Screening Testing:**

- The District will continue to offer free SHIELD PCR testing for diagnostic testing for suspected cases, close contacts, and during outbreaks, as well as screening testing for unvaccinated staff and students according to CDC's testing recommendation.
- The hierarchy of testing is first for persons with symptoms of COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status, followed by close contacts to a confirmed case, and all staff and students with possible exposure in the context of an outbreak.
- Testing may also be used for screening purposes. In moderate, substantial and high transmission, screening testing is recommended for individuals not fully vaccinated at least once per week.
- Screening testing is recommended for high risk sports and activities according to transmission:
  - Low & Moderate: Screening once per week for participants not fully vaccinated
  - o Substantial: Screening twice per week for participants not fully vaccinated

- High: Screening twice per week for participants not fully vaccinated and CDC guidance includes consideration of pausing high risk sports or activities while in high transmission to protect in-person learning.
- Screening testing is recommended for low and intermediate risk sports according to transmission:
  - Moderate, Substantial and High: Screening at least once per week for participants who are not fully vaccinated.
- Screening testing is recommended when a school may be in outbreak status.
- Parent consent is needed for student testing.
- Parents are highly encouraged to approve the <u>Testing Consent Form</u> at the beginning of the school year to accommodate prompt testing should the need arise.
- A <u>Testing Consent Form</u> can be completed by clicking here.

### **Ventilation:**

• Enhanced ventilation practices are in effect, including the installation of HEPA filtration systems, and the opening of building doors and windows.

### **Practices and Procedures**

### **Academics:**

- Traditional academic practices and grading procedures will be in effect for the 2021-2022 school year. Specifics of these practices and procedures are detailed in the Curriculum Guide, Student Handbook, and individual course syllabi.
- The traditional academic calendar will be followed in regards to reporting student grades, progress reporting periods, and final exams. There will not be a "Bridge Week" that was utilized at the end of each semester during the 2020-2021 school year.
- If a student is under mandatory quarantine, they are expected to be present in all academic classes and TEAM remotely, following the daily bell schedule on a temporary basis while in quarantine. Remote attendance will begin in a reasonable period of time, allowing for the notification and preparation of individual teachers.

### **Assigned Seating:**

Students will have assigned seating in every classroom and must remain in seats.
 Physical distancing of 3' will take place in classrooms, to the greatest extent possible.

### **Athletics & Activities:**

- Athletics and activities will be permitted to occur with all activities complying with health and safety procedures set forth by IDPH, IHSA, and District 124.
- Students must meet eligibility requirements for participation.
- Activities may be paused at any time by directive, illness or other.

### **Attendance Expectations:**

- All students are expected to attend in-person daily\*.
- Normal attendance policies will be in effect for the 2021-2022 school year. If students
  will not be attending classes as scheduled, parents/guardians must call the attendance
  office prior to 10:00 A.M. to report the absence.
- Synchronous remote instruction will only be made available for students **while they are under mandatory quarantine** consistent with guidance or requirements from a local public health department or the Illinois Department of Public Health.
- If you are eligible for remote instruction while under required quarantine and are not present remotely, you will be considered absent.
- \*Unless approved for a fully remote learning option via Edgenuity and/or Illinois Virtual High School.

#### Cafeteria:

- Physical distancing of 3' will take place in the cafeteria, to the greatest extent possible.
- Students will be assigned to the Commons or the Senior Cafe for their assigned lunch period.

- With 3' of social distancing required while students are eating, individual student desks or high top cafe tables will replace traditional round cafeteria tables.
- Meals are at no cost to students during the 2021-2022 school year.
- Student meals shall not be dropped off for the 2021-22 school year.
- No food is permitted outside of designated eating areas.

#### **Field Trips:**

• Field trips may be limited until state and local health officials have determined that it is safe to resume them. We will encourage teachers to pursue virtual activities and events in lieu of field trips.

#### **Learning Management System Expectations:**

- Technology is an important tool to support teaching and learning. All District 124 staff and students will be expected to utilize Schoology as a digital hub for instruction and communication.
- Teachers will continue to post instructional expectations every day in Schoology.

#### Lockers:

- Use of lockers will be permitted.
- Students should not congregate at lockers.
- Locker use may be restricted, if necessary.

#### **Transportation:**

- School buses will operate at normal capacity.
- Regardless of vaccination status, masks must be worn by all individuals while on a school bus (<u>CDC Order</u>).
- Student pick up in the afternoon will take place at Door #1 and Door #14 (see Appendix B). The District will make every effort to maintain open parking spaces in the north lot for parents to utilize while awaiting students at the end of the day. Please exercise caution when picking up students as more students may be picked up than is typical.
- Students do need a parking permit to drive themselves and park on campus.

#### **Visitors:**

- For individuals that need to visit campus, all safety protocols in place for staff and students shall be followed.
- All visitors shall enter through Door #1.
- Masks shall be required for all teachers, staff, students, and visitors in school and when on school buses, regardless of vaccination status.

## **Unique Academic Course Modifications**

#### **Behind the Wheel Instruction:**

Behind-the-Wheel instruction is underway and will continue as long as the following mandated minimum safety standards below are followed:

- Face coverings must be worn, unless medically contraindicated.
- No eating and drinking in the vehicle.
- Windows will be open whenever possible.
- Only stops applicable to driver's education will be made to reduce the amount of time in the vehicle.




