As a reminder, here are the highlights for the upcoming transition:

- Monday, April 12 – all students may attend in-person on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays
- We will maintain the synchronous learning option for families that wish to continue to learn at home. Teachers will continue to teach synchronously every period, with students learning both in-person and at home.
- Wednesday's will continue to be flex schedule days, with no students attending in-person learning. Students are expected to be engaged, and attendance will be taken on Wednesdays; however, synchronous learning will continue to not be universally required. Additionally, building-wide deep cleaning will take place on Wednesdays.
- Additional guidance will be forthcoming in the very near future regarding student pickup and drop-off, student parking, bus transportation, student lunch locations, end of semester planning, etc.
